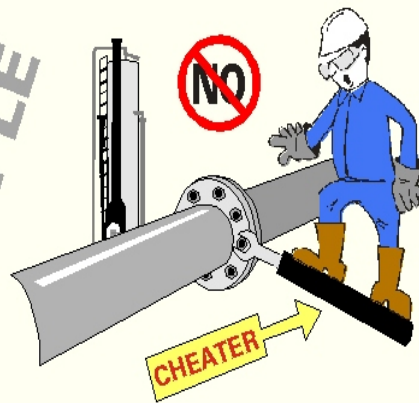


ACCIDENTS START WHERE SAFETY ENDS!



THE CORRECT USE OF A CHEATER

- ✓ Extensions or cheaters *must not* be used on wrench handles until efforts to break out or make up the connection with the largest wrench available have failed.
- ✓ If an extension is used, place it on the largest readily available wrench.
- ✓ The extension *must* extend the full length of the handle so that it will *not* damage the wrench or slip off the handle.
- ✓ *Never* use an extension on a crescent-type wrench or an aluminum wrench.
- ✓ Aluminum extensions *must* be schedule 80 or greater.
- ✓ Fiberglass extensions *must not* be used.
- ✓ Avoid awkward body position.
- ✓ Do not stand on cheater.
