- 1. ALWAYS READ AND FOLLOW LABEL DIRECTIONS.
- 2. HAVE AN ADULT PRESENT.
- 3. BUY FROM RELIABLE SELLERS.
- 4. USE OUTDOORS ONLY.
- 5. ALWAYS HAVE WATER HANDY (A GARDEN HOSE AND A BUCKET).
- 6. NEVER EXPERIMENT OR MAKE YOUR OWN FIREWORKS.
- 7. LIGHT ONLY ONE FIREWORK AT A TIME.
- NEVER RE-LIGHT A "DUD" FIREWORK (WAIT 15 TO 20 MINUTES AND THEN SOAK IT IN A BUCKET OF WATER).
- 9. NEVER GIVE FIREWORKS TO SMALL CHILDREN.
- 10. IF NECESSARY, STORE FIREWORKS IN A COOL, DRY PLACE.
- 11. DISPOSE OF FIREWORKS PROPERLY BY SOAKING THEM IN WATER AND THEN DISPOSING OF THEM IN YOUR TRASH CAN.
- 12. NEVER THROW OR POINT FIREWORKS AT OTHER PEOPLE.
- 13. NEVER CARRY FIREWORKS IN YOUR POCKET.
