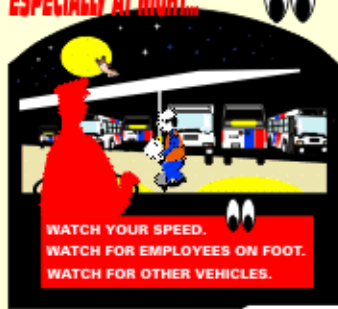

PROPER PROCEDURES FOR NAVIGATING A RAILROAD GRADE CROSSING STOP

1. STAY BEHIND LOWER APPROACHES.
2. APPROXIMATE 100 FEET BEFORE THE CROSSING STOP.

- DRIVE BEHIND THE SPEED LIMIT.
- BEWARE OF AN ONCOMING TRAIN.
- TRAINS COME WITH YOU!
- DRIVE SLOWLY BEHIND THE TRAINS.

SAFETY TIPS:

- ✓ STOP IN A SAFE PLACE.
- ✓ COME TO A COMPLETE STOP BEFORE OPENING DOORS.
- ✓ BE SURE PASSENGERS ARE CLEAR BEFORE OPENING OR CLOSING DOORS.
- ✓ CHECK MIRRORS BEFORE PULLING AWAY FROM CURB.
- ✓ ALLOW TIME FOR ELDERLY OR DISABLED TO BE SEATED.

REMEMBER: MAKE SMOOTH STARTS AND STOPS. EXPECT VEHICLES TO CUT IN FRONT OF YOUR BUS!

SAFETY TIPS:

1. REDUCE SPEED IN RAIN OR FOG.
2. INCREASE FOLLOWING DISTANCE.
3. AVOID QUICK OR ABRUPT TURNING MOVEMENTS.
4. AVOID HYDROPLANING.
5. EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED.
6. KEEP YOUR VEHICLE UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.

INTERSECTIONS



KNOW WHERE YOU'RE GOING AND WHAT LANE TO BE IN BEFORE ENTERING THE INTERSECTION.
SHOW OTHERS YOUR INTENTIONS BY COMMUNICATING. USE YOUR SIGNALS.
SLOW DOWN BEFORE APPROACHING INTERSECTION.
GO THROUGH ONLY IF IT'S CLEAR, SAFE AND YOUR TURN.

STAY ALERT

DON'T STAY IN THE INTERSECTION SO LONG THAT YOU BECOME A HAZARD!

SAFETY TIPS:

- WATCH OUT FOR "RED LIGHT" RUNNERS.
- DON'T EXPECT OTHER DRIVERS TO YIELD TO YOU.
- BE PREPARED TO COME TO A COMPLETE SMOOTH STOP.
- EXPECT DRIVERS TO DO UNEXPECTED THINGS AT INTERSECTIONS.
- TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SIGNALS CAN REGULATE TRAFFIC, BUT THEY CANNOT PREVENT ACCIDENTS.

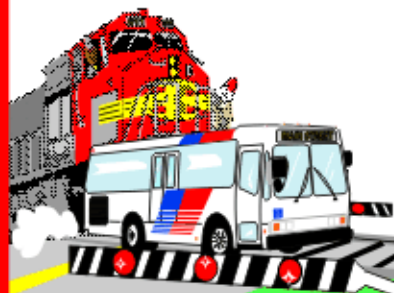
PREVENTABLE COLLISIONS
